We hereby certify

 For the treatment of sleep apnea
 can be used on the Jewish Sabbath and Holidays
 according to the following stipulations:

Model	Features	Instructions for Shabbat
IN101	Fixed operating without automatic adjusting and not activated by breath	1. The machine must be run on a Shabbat timer which was set before the beginning of Shabbat 2. If a power failure occurs - the device will resume operation with the renewal of the electrical current
IN201S	Devices with Fixed operating or with automatic adjusting can be activated push button (weekday) or by breath	1. There is no Halachic problem in using the 'auto' mode that tracks and responds to each breath. 2. There is somewhat a Halachic preference to cancel prior to Shabbat the first activating mode by breathing itself, as this equipment functions on weekdays (see Note A). 3. If activating by breathing is necessary because of habit or for reasons of convenience or due to concern of power failure (see Note A) One may also use the activating mode by breathing itself

Notes:

- All settings must be made before the beginning of Shabbat and the digital display must be covered so that one cannot read.
- The standard device, IN101, must be activated before Shabbat by push button and the other devices also if you give up on the activating mode by breathing (and 'risk' the failure to resume in the case of a power failure).
- If one desires to use the device with water, the water must be put in the device before the beginning of Shabbat and cannot be added during Shabbat.
